2019 Anti-Corruption Education Campus Advocacy Bus Arrives in Penghu and Invites you to Join the Effort of Anti-Corruption, Wildlife Conservation, and Protecting Sea Turtles

The “Advocacy Bus Tour for Anti-Corruption Education on Campus” arrived in Penghu today (29). The Cleanie mascots launched the event by meeting the four knights for anti-corruption in Penghu County with the Sea Turtle dance, which was combined with the local sea turtle release for the teaching of ocean conservation, and the delicately set up challenges for anti-corruption. About 400 local students participated to experience the educational meaning of anti-corruption, wildlife conservation, and sea turtle protection.

To resonate with and to implement the anti-corruption education advocated in the United Nations Convention Against Corruption, and to make others understand the efforts and determination of the Agency Against Corruption, Ministry of Justice in continuously promoting anti-corruption education, the Agency has coordinated and held the “Advocacy Bus Tour for Anti-Corruption Education on Campus” in 2019, and eight stops around Taiwan were set as major event venues. The tour has visited New Taipei City and Taichung City

with good receptions. Today (29), the event is held in the Seashell Building of Shili Beach, Penghu County and attended by the Deputy Director-General of the Agency, Jung-Chou Chen and joined in the advocacy of anti-corruption education and the ocean conservation idea of “less greediness, zero waste, and sea turtle protection” by the Penghu County Mayor, Feng-Wei Lai, Director of the Ocean Conservation Administration, Ocean Affairs Council, Hsiang-Wen Huang, Chief Justice of the Taiwan Penghu District Court, Shu-Hui Li, Prosecutor General of the Taiwan Penghu District Prosecutor’s Office, Mou-Hsin Huang, Penghu County Commissioner, Chao-Ling Liu-Chen, Magong Mayor Chu-Lin Yeh, and Director of the National Penghu University of Science and Technology, Cheng-Kuo Chen.

Through integrating resources of different fields, the activity has the effect of general education. In addition to the sea turtle release activity held by Penghu County Government, challenges full of educational meaning of anti-corruption specially set up by 10 government employee ethics units of Ministry of Economic Affairs, Ministry of Finance, Council of Agriculture, Executive Yuan, Ocean Conservation Administration, Ocean Affairs Council, Taipei City Government, New Taipei City Government, Taichung City Government, Kaohsiung City Government, Taitung County Government, and Penghu County Government were there to allow participating students to understand the importance of anti-corruption and integrity as well as ocean conservation.

The Advocacy Bus Tour for Anti-Corruption Education on Campus will next hold the event “Read for Good Morals, Anti-Corruption for Mental Strength” in Wenhua Elementary School in Taoyuan City on June 25. By combining anti-corruption education and innovative technology, the AI robot will integrate the teaching of anti-corruption and integrity into students’ daily activities.
