2019 Training Course on Ethics Campus Propaganda Series in Taitung

Speak Out Aloud on Integrity in Your Ethnic Language!

“Training Course on Ethics Campus Propaganda Series” came to Taitung County, where it is characterized for the diversified ethnic integration, today (11th Day). During the performance of the PAI-WAN traditional dance, YA LJB accompanied the children on the site and made them speak out on the definitions represented by “integrity,” “honesty,” “non-greedy,” “justice” and “fairness” in their respective ethnic languages.

To respond to and practice the anti-corruption education initiative advocated by the preventive measures under the “United Nations Convention against Corruption” and to enable outsiders to have the picture on the hardworking and determination of Agency Against Corruption, Ministry of Justice in continuous furtherance of the training course on ethics, the Agency planned the “Training Course on Ethics Campus Propaganda Series” in 2019, and chose to stop at 8 major locations throughout Taiwan. The event was organized in Taitung County Stadium on the 11th day, where a total of 310 faculty and

students were invited from Sin Sheng Elementary School, Ren-Ai Elementary School, Ma-Lan Elementary School, National Taitung University Laboratory Elementary School, and Jie Da Ma-Lan Elementary School, which handled the opening show.

What does integrity mean? The Mayor of Taitung County, Yao Ching-Ling, Deputy Director-General of AAC, Hou Kuan-Jen, and Chief Prosecutor of Taitung District Prosecutors Office, Chang Hsiao-Wen, and Chief Judge of Taitung District Court, Liu Chang-Yi told everyone on the site in their ethnic languages and simple words that integrity is being honest, non-greedy, just and fair, to enable the present young students to know about the real intent of integrity expressed in their ethnic languages.

Multiple challenges painstakingly designed by the ethics offices of 15 government entities including Taitung County Government and Ministry of Economic Affairs, Ministry of Finance, Ministry of Transportation and Communications, Ministry of National Defense, Council of Agriculture (Executive Yuan), Ocean Conservation Administration (Ocean Affairs Council), Taipei City Government, New Taipei City Government, Taichung City Government, Tainan City Government, Kaohsiung City Government, Keelung City Government, Pingtung County Government and Penghu County Government were made available to communicate the integrity and ethics philosophy on the site, by combining education with entertainment.

Next, the “Training Course on Ethics Campus Propaganda Series” will make its debut at the Sihwei Administration Center of Kaohsiung City Hall on September 17. By integrating the concept about integrity and ethics into the design of the escape games and riddles, we expect to enable the child students to realize the value of practicing integrity and ethics from the interaction practiced

through teamwork and brainstorming games. We sincerely invite you to join us to work on the training course on ethics for our next generation.
