AAC urges the government agencies at all levels to convene integrity report meetings for the review, supervision, evaluation, and consultation of anti-corruption operations. Generally, the head of the agencies act as the coordinator of the meetings, while external monitoring and advising powers are brought in. External experts and impartial third-parties are invited for analyzing integrity-related risks and enhancing risk control. 1,165 integrity report meetings were held across the government sectors in 2021, 84.89% were chaired by the heads of the agencies, 1,784 special reports were presented, 2,495 proposals were approved, with 76.8% of cases subject to further-monitoring in the resolutions completed.
