

## Integrity Awards - Evaluation Criteria

**Integrity Awards – The evaluation criterias for the “Overall Integrity Behavior of the Agency”** include four basic evaluation categories involving “Chief’s determination and continuous acts of integrity,” “Information and administrative transparency,” “Risk prevention and accountability” and “Demonstration of the effectiveness of integrity”, and one advanced evaluation category, namely “Clean and competent innovation and diffusion,” for a total of 100 points.
