

Government agencies (institutions) include





Enterprises
which are solely
owned by the
State



Enterprises jointly owned by the State and private individuals, established in accordance with special business organization laws



Enterprises, which, in accordance with the Company Act, are jointly owned by the State and private individuals, and in which the State holds more than 50% of the capital

State-owned enterprises as defined in Article 3 of the State-Owned Enterprise Management Act





Enterprises in which the government and its affiliated enterprise funds or non-profit funds have cumulatively invested 20% or more of the enterprise's total capital, whether through indirect investment or reinvestment



Foundations whose personnel, finances, or operations are directly or indirectly controlled by the government



Enterprises whose personnel, finances, or operations are directly or indirectly controlled by the government, whether through indirect investment or reinvestment

Government-controlled enterprises, groups, or institutions refers to those announced by the Ministry of Civil Service
