

Results of 2024 Nationwide Case Review by Agency Against Corruption

In 2024, Agency Against Corruption (AAC) continued to refer to issues of public concern and requested the government ethics units of the competent authorities to conduct in-depth inventories of operations with potential corruption risks based on the integrity risk assessment results of their respective agencies. **Seven** major issues were selected: “**high-risk audit and inspection operations,**” “**various types of subsidies,**” “**green energy and environmental protection projects,**” “**procurements for major construction, facility installation, and maintenance,**” “**Procurements in remote areas or agencies and schools without government ethics units,**” “**outsourced or commissioned projects,**” and “**integrity risk personnel business inspections.**” Through systematic investigations, the AAC sought to prevent corruption and unlawful conduct, while actively assisting agencies in establishing internal control and anti-corruption mechanisms, so as to fulfill the work value of the AAC in safeguarding public welfare.
