- Active Bribery
- Passive Bribery
- Bribery of Foreign Officials
- Bribery on behalf of a company

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UK Bribery Act 2010

Six Principles of Compliance:

- Adequate Procedures
- Top Level Commitment
- Risk Assessment
- Due Diligence
- Talk to & train staff on anti corruption
- Monitor and Review

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Key Themes in UK Bribery Act 2010

- Aim to encourage establishment of a bribery prevention culture within Business organisations
- Proportionality and defining theme

- Awareness Raising
- Standard Setting
