2. Overview of service execution (August 1-August 31, 2017)

Active search for clues for malfeasance and corruption and meticulous investigation of criminal evidence

The Agency actively searches for clues and conducts follow-up investigations in a meticulous manner and supervises civil service ethics departments of competent authorities in their conscientious search and detection of clues for involvement of public servants in corruption and malfeasance to increase conviction rates for such crimes:

- (1) In August 2017, the Agency processed and investigated a total of 7 accepted cases on record reported by citizens (a total of 105 cases have been investigated this year)
- (2) In August 2017, the Agency investigated a total of 64 accepted cases on record submitted by civil service ethics departments (a total of 408 cases have been investigated this year). A total of 7 accepted cases became investigated cases this month (total of 40 this year)
